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INTERNATIONAL GRAD STUDENT POLICY

From time to time there have been applications to attend NHCS by Foreign Students who have already graduated from high school, or it's equivalent, in their native land. Reasons for attending here may be varied, from cultural experience to obtaining of an American Diploma. In considering these factors we have established this policy:

- 1. Whereas society often considers a high school graduate an adult with freedoms and responsibilities pertaining to that status, an inherent independence mind-set may be a potential concern. Any student attending NHCS must agree to the established Authority Structure, beginning with the School Board of Directors and flowing down to the Teachers/Staff.*
- 2. Whereas the concept of a student attending for "Cultural Exchange" is valid in theory, we question how that would affect the student's motivation to attend classes and strive for academic success. Since this school's mission is to invest Biblical, value-based education into lives of the students, our primary focus is in Christian Academics. Cultural experiences are secondary in priority. Any student attending NHCS must have as a motivation the increasing of scholastic and Biblical learning.*
- 3. To accomplish the previous two points, it is the stipulation of this policy that when a student has already graduated and wishes to attend New Hope, he/she must attend with the focus of acquiring a NHCS diploma by accomplishing a full academic schedule, as determined by NHCS personnel. Academic failure or lack of effort would constitute reason enough for the acceptance to be terminated and the student required to return home.*
