## Following your acceptance at New Hope Christian Schools - - -

### \*Process of Obtaining a Student Visa The I-901 Fee Payment

1. You have applied and have been accepted to New Hope Christian Schools (NHCS), the next step is to obtain a Student Visa (F-1).
2. NHCS has enclosed an **I-20 Form**, "Certificate of Eligibility for Nonimmigrant (F-1) Student." The Form I-20 is essential to obtaining a visa.
3. After receiving the I-20, you will need to make an **I-901 fee payment** (\$200) directly to the U.S. government; this is a government fee and not a school fee. You will need to go to a U.S. government web site and complete a "Form I-901." Visit the site below for instructions:

After you make payment, make sure you print out your RECEIPT.

4. Make an appointment with a U.S. Embassy or Consulate for a visa interview. Ask what documents are required.
5. When you go for the interview, make sure you have all required documents, including the receipt for the I-901 fee, passport, and original I-20
6. At the interview, you will need to meet certain criteria:
  - a. Sufficient English proficiency
  - b. Sufficient funds to cover expenses
  - c. Adequate proof you will pursue academic studies
  - d. Adequate proof that upon completion of studies, you will return to your home country.
  - e. We believe in you, as do your parents.
7. At the interview, relax and try not to be too nervous. Smile and be friendly!

May you be successful in obtaining a visa and be able to come to New Hope Christian Schools!
